The Gals Lead Teen Program is delivered in a variety of formats (conferences, workshops, and retreats) and generally in collaboration with organizations serving teen girls. The Program includes an online community support forum, a success newsletter for teens, and scholarships for skills training and development.

CLUB INCLUDES

SAND DOLLAR Club (\$100):

- Sends 1 teen girl through the Weekend Conference Experience

STARFISH Club (\$500):

- Sends 5 teen girls through the Weekend Conference Experience, or
- Provides one \$500 scholarship award, or
- Provides support for one mini workshop a year

MERMAID Club (\$1000):

- Sends 10 teen girls through the Weekend Conference Experience, or
- Provides one \$1000 scholarship award, or
- Provides support for two mini workshops a year, or
- Provides support for the day long retreat

PEARL Club (\$2500):

- Sends 25 teen girls through the Weekend Conference Experience, or
- Provides two \$1000 scholarship awards and one \$500 scholarship awards, or
- Provides support for all mini workshops a year and one \$500 scholarship award, or
- Provides Program support for 3 months

All club members enjoy an annual gratitude breakfast in the Spring to honor your contributions to the Program.
